

Paloma Krõõt Tupay is a constitutional lawyer with an Estonian-German-Colombian background. Thus, fundamental rights issues are part of her everyday work tasks, within which she has repeatedly cooperated with FRA. While working at the Estonian Ministry of Justice in 2014/2015, she served as FRA's National Liaison Officer for Estonia. In 2017, during the Estonian Presidency to the Council of the EU, Paloma K served as Chair of the Working Party on Fundamental Rights, Citizens Rights and Free Movement of Persons (FREMP). Today, she teaches constitutional law at the University of Tartu in Estonia, focusing her research activities i.a on issues of data protection, e-government and digital constitutionalism. In this context, she has also been part of a study on the impact of Artificial intelligence and big data on the fundamental rights in the EU requested by FRA. Paloma K. is also a member of the Supervisory Council of the Estonian Human Rights Centre.
