6. Annexes to the Financial Statements

I. General Information

The European Monitoring Centre on Racism and Xenophobia (EUMC) was an independent body of the European Union established by Council Regulation (EC) No 1035/97 of 2 June 1997 (OJ L 151, 10 June 1997), which was amended by Council Regulation (EC) No 1652/2003 of 18 June 2003.

On 15 February 2007 the Council adopted Regulation 168/2007 which extended the EUMC's mandate and transformed it into the European Union Agency for Fundamental Rights (FRA) which became operational on 1 March 2007. The comparative amounts shown relate to the final accounts of the EUMC for 2006.

The FRA is based in Vienna and its primary objective is to provide the relevant institutions, bodies, offices and agencies of the Community and its Member States when implementing Community law with assistance and expertise relating to fundamental rights in order to support them when they take measures or formulate courses of action within their respective spheres of competence to fully respect fundamental rights.

II. Legal Basis

The accounts are kept in accordance with the provisions of Title VII of the Financial Regulation of the FRA as adopted by its Management Board on 23 October 2007. These accounting provisions are the same as Title VII of the Framework Financial Regulation for the bodies referred to in Article 185 of Council Regulation (EC, EURATOM) No. 1605/2002 on the Financial Regulation applicable to the general budget of the European Communities, as amended by Council Regulation (EC, Euratom) N° 1995/2006 of 13 December 2006.

III. Accounting Rules and Principles

The FRA's financial statements have been prepared in accordance with the accounting rules adopted by the Commission's Accounting Officer on 28 December 2004, together with all subsequent amendments, which in turn are based on the International Public Accounting Standards.

The financial statements have been drawn up in accordance with the generally accepted accounting principles specified in Article 78 of the Financial Regulation of the FRA, namely:

- · going concern basis
- prudence
- consistent accounting methods
- comparability of information
- materiality
- no netting
- reality over appearance
- accrual-based accounting

IV. Notes to the Financial Statements

a) Reporting Currency

The reporting currency is Euro (€). Some figures may be subject to rounding differences.

Assets and liabilities that exist in currencies other than the Euro at 31 December 2007 are converted into Euro on the basis of the exchange rate ruling at that date, except for tangible and intangible assets, which retain their value in Euro at the rate applied when they were purchased.

During the year revenue and expenditure incurred in currencies other than the Euro are converted into Euro on the monthly exchange rates published by the European Commission. Realised gains and losses are taken into account in the economic outturn account of the corresponding year.

b) Fixed Assets

Tangible or intangible items acquired whose purchase price or production cost is € 420 or more, with a period of use greater than one year and which are not consumables, are recorded as fixed assets.

In accordance with Accounting Rules 6 and 7 of the Commission, fixed assets are valued at their purchase price or production cost and are subject to depreciation on a straight line basis over their useful economic lives. The annual depreciation rates applied are as follows:

Software licences Computer hardware 25% 25%

Computer nardware Furniture and vehicles

10% and 25% (vehicles)

Plant and equipment

25% and 12.5% (mail and health & safety related equipment)

During 2006 the useful life of furniture was increased from four years to ten years in order to bring it into line with the Commission's policy. The 2006 depreciation charge for Furniture and Vehicles reflects the net impact of this change in accounting estimate for all years up to and including 2006. Details of the depreciation charge for furniture for 2006 are as follows:

3. Bank guarantees provided to suppliers

As part of the rental agreement relating to the new premises mentioned above, on 21st December 2007 Raiffeisen Zentralbank Oesterriech AG provided a bank guarantee to the landlord for an amount of €1,000,000. The guarantee is valid for one year but may be automatically extended by the bank each year.

There were no guarantees provided to suppliers at the end of 2006.

2. Rental contract for new premises

On 21st December 2007 the FRA signed a rental contract for new office premises and the handover of the premises to the FRA is scheduled for 30 June 2008. The handover is subject to the Austrian authorities agreeing to contribute to the rental costs of the new premises and the satisfactory completion of the necessary building work that is required to be undertaken.

Should the handover be completed successfully on 30 June 2008 as foreseen, the minimum lease period would be ten years. The future minimum lease payments under this non cancellable operating lease would be:

Pension Obligations

The FRA's staff are members of the European Communities Pension Scheme which is a defined benefit pension plan.

A defined benefit plan is a pension plan that generally defines an amount of pension benefit that an employee will receive on retirement, usually dependent on one or more factors such as age and years of service. FRA staff contribute 10.25% of their basic salaries to the pension scheme and an additional 20.5% contribution is made by the European Commission. The cost to the European Commission is not reflected in the FRA's accounts.

Future benefits payable to FRA staff under the European Communities Pension Scheme are accounted for in the accounts of the European Commission. No provisions for such pensions are made in these accounts.

V. Reconciliation between budgetary outturn and economic outturn

The FRA's financial statements are prepared on an accruals basis, where transactions are recorded in the period to which they relate. The result for the year using this basis is indicated in the economic outturn account. However, the FRA uses a modified cash accounting system for preparing the budget outturn account and its other budgetary reporting. In this system only the payments made and revenues received in the period are recorded, together with payment appropriations that are carried forward.
