

#### **Question 1**:

I would be grateful if you could explain to me the relation of this call to the earlier one this year... [t]here seems to be a significant overlap between the two calls, so I am wondering what happened with the first, and how it fits in this part of FRA's project?

#### Answer 1:

The first call was to survey attitudes of passengers (third country nationals) to the collection of biometrics. It covered a limited number of border crossing points and was implemented in the broader context of the EU LISA pilot project.

This call is wider as it concerns interviews and small-scale surveys with a much larger number of actors (various authorities, right holders, providers of legal assistance).
