Veronika Bílková is the head of the Centre for International Law at the Institute of International Relations in Prague and associate professor in international law at the Faculty of Law of the Charles University in Prague. She graduated from the Faculties of Law and Philosophy of the Charles University and has the E.MA in Human Rights and Democratisation and the Diploma in International Law from the University of Cambridge. She was a research fellow at the Université Paris II, the Max Planck Institute for Comparative Public Law and International Law, the University of Northumbria and the Columbia Law School. Since 2010, she has been the member of the European Commission for Democracy Through Law of the Council of Europe (Venice Commission) on behalf of the Czech Republic. She is also the Vice-President of the European Society of International Law (ESIL) and a member of the ESIL Board. She has authored several books and some 100 articles in Czech, English and French on international law (human rights, international humanitarian law, the use of force, fight against terrorism) and international relations (human rights foreign policy, security, international organizations).
