Marie-Laure Basilien-Gainche is specialised in EU law, migration law, human rights law, and constitutional comparative law. She is associated with numerous research centres, such as the French Collaborative Institute on Migration, the Centre for Research and Studies on Fundamental Rights (Paris Nanterre University), the Centre for Migration Law (Radboud University, Nijmegen), the Global Migration Center (Graduate Institute, Geneva), the Border Criminologies group (Oxford University), and the Center for the Legal Study of Borders and Migration (Queen Mary University, London). Her research focus on assessing the legitimacy of the political systems and legal decisions of the European Union and its member states, considering the crisis situations (i.e. the use of exceptional measures in the name of the fight against terrorism or the sanitary crisis) and the apprehension of spaces of confinement of migrants (i.e. borders, camps and detention centers). She tends to explore how exceptions to the rule of law and violations of human rights occur. As member of the Institut Universitaire de France (junior 2012-2017; senior 2023-2028),
