Professor Ph.D. Nicolae VOICULESCU graduated from the Faculty of Law and the Faculty of Philosophy-History at the University of Bucharest. He also benefited from a scholarship on human rights at the United Nations Council for Human Rights in Geneva and Strasbourg, as well as a course in International Relations and Diplomacy at the University of Leeds.

Currently, Professor Voiculescu has the tenure of the Human Rights course at Titu Maiorescu University in Bucharest. At the same time, he is Director of the Council for Doctoral Studies, assimilated to the position of University Vice-Rector.

Professor Voiculescu has significant professional experience as a diplomat in the Human Rights Department of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs. In this capacity, he was part of the specialized committee of the Council of Europe on the occasion of the reform process of the ECHR control mechanism.

He was also the Representative in Romania of the International Labour Organization and had the quality of parliamentary counsellor to the Legal Commission of the Chamber of Deputies of the Parliament of Romania during the process of harmonization of national and European legislation.

He is the Editor-in-Chief of the Romanian Journal of Labour Law and of the Law Review of Titu Maiorescu University.

He is the author of 22 specialty books and 75 articles in the field of international social law and has taught at universities in France and Italy.
