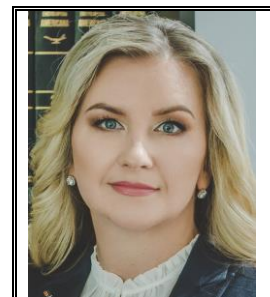

Dr. Lyra Jakuleviciene is an international and European Union law professor at Mykolas Romeris University (MRU) (Lithuania). Over 20 years of her professional experience combines research, training and international consultancies on human rights, non-discrimination, free movement in the EU, asylum and migration issues. She held various positions at UNHCR and UNDP (1997-2013). Currently, she serves as the Dean of the largest Law School in Lithuania. She is an active member of European academic networks, an author of over 40 scientific publications and two books. Has worked on more than 20 human rights related projects and lead Human Rights research laboratory of MRU (2015-2019). Among her recent research topics were consequences for human rights in the context of the responses to the pandemic, business and human rights, alternatives to detention, situation of unaccompanied minors and others.
