A court of first instance decided that by writing the comments, M.J. publicly incited violence and physical violent treatment of Muslims on a grounds of nationality, publicly ridiculed, expressed contempt for, and urged hatred of refugees (Article 170 (paragraphs 2 and 3) of the Criminal Code.	M.J. was given a fine of €1129.80, but the fine was reduced to €753.20 on the ground that the case has ended by the court penal order and the accused fully admitted his guilt. Under the Code of Criminal Procedure, it is permitted to deviate from the model of general criminal procedure and the criminal procedure can be ended by means of a court penal order when the stipulated conditions are met.	M.J. fully admitted his guilt. "Prohibition provided in Article 170 of the Criminal Code is based on the provisions of Article 25(4) of the Constitution of the Republic of Lithuania, according to which the freedom to express convictions and to impart information shall be incompatible with criminal actions—incitement to national, racial, religious, or social hatred, incitement to violence or to discrimination, as well as defamation and disinformation."
