The defendant wrote "A very good opportunity to ... you know what ... BOOM". | Suspended sentence of 60 days imprisonment. The lower court found the defendant guilty of violating § 266 b, section 1 and § 136, section 1 in the criminal code. Concerning the sentencing the court stated that the violations were committed in July 2015, and that it was not the defendant's fault that the court case was not pursued within reasonable time. The court found that the sentence should be suspended. | The court found him guilty of violating § 266 b, section 1 and § 136, section 1 in the criminal code. Taking the context of the statement into consideration, the lower court found that the defendant had incited that a serious crime be committed. The lower court further found that the statement was suited to threaten a group of people on the basis of their religion. | No key issues can be drawn on the basis of this particular case. | "En rigtig god mulighed for at ....
