She was also accused of incitement to hatred and public defamation against a group of persons by making extremist materials.	Only relates to custody, which was replaced by probation. Note: Since the defendant violated the conditions of her probation, she was sent to prison in April 2017.	Since the case of the Supreme Court of The Slovak Republic involves mainly the question of defendant's custody and annulment of the court order for preparatory proceedings, there is no further argumentation outside the scope of the key facts of the case.
