The defendant was indicted for harassing his neighbour and neighbour's wife while intoxicated, yelling profanities like "f**k your Muslim mother", among others.	The perpetrator was found guilty for a misdemeanour, breaking Article 25 of the Anti-Discrimination Act of Croatia, and was charged a fine in the amount of 5.000 kn. He was also found guilty of breaking Article 13 of The Offenses against Public Order and Peace Act.	The Court found the perpetrator guilty for a misdemeanour, breaking Article 25 of the Anti-discrimination Act of Croatia. The Court found that based on Article 25, the defendant, with the aim to intimidate or to create a hostile, degrading or offensive environment on the grounds of a difference in ethnic affiliation and religion hurt their neighbours' dignity.
