The picture depicted a police officer and a refugee playing on the road. The defendant wrote the following about refugees: "They come here to get a better life and think they will get everything served on a platter when they land here. There is only one thing to say and that is what the Polish minister of foreign affairs said "they are human garbage" and they have nothing ... nothing to do here..." The defendant plead not guilty because he thought that the Facebook group was private. He also deleted his comment after he found out that his friends on Facebook could read it.	Both the lower and the higher court acquitted the defendant.	The lower court and the higher court both acquitted the defendant. Both courts found that it was not proven that the defendant had the intent to address the statement to a broader audience. However, it was undisputed that the statement was taunting and demeaning towards a group of people.		"De kommer her for at få et bedre liv og tror de får det serveret på en platte når de lander her.
