This response has gained ten percentage points since spring 2015 (from 51% up to 61%), and has now reached a record high. However, it evokes a negative feeling for a third of EU citizens (33%, -2 percentage points since spring 2016, -8 since autumn 2014). Meanwhile, the immigration of people from outside the EU evokes a negative feeling for a majority of Europeans (56%, -2), but the proportion of respondents who see immigration from outside the EU in a positive light continues to grow (37%, +3 percentage points since spring 2016), reaching its highest level since autumn 2014, when the question was first asked.	Between the 3rd and the 16th November 2016, TNS opinion & social, a consortium created between TNS political & social, TNS UK and TNS opinion, carried out the wave 86.2 of the EUROBAROMETER survey, on request of the EUROPEAN COMMISSION.	The wave 86.2 is the STANDARD EUROBAROMETER 86 and covers the population of the respective nationalities of the European Union Member States, resident in each of the 28 Member States and aged 15 years and over.
