Hate crime, Racism & xenophobia	Cyprus, Anti-discrimination Authority	The report is the product of a own-initiative ex officio investigation criticizing the handling of two specific outbreaks of racial violence at schools by the school authorities and by the Ministry of Education for their failure to identify a motive in the acts. The report attributed the failure of the Ministry and of the school authorities partly to an effort not to amplify the problem and partly to ignorance as to what constitutes racial violence and how this differs from other types of violence. The report concludes that the perceptions and practices that victimize the foreign students are not condemned and dealt with decisively either by the Ministry of Education or by the schools and called on the Ministry to work with the Equality Body in order to compile a code of conduct against racism at schools.
