The huge disparities between official and civil society figures should lead the police and judicial authorities in the first instance to question their statistics on racism. They should also consider whether the judicial system is sufficiently accessible for victims of racism and homo/transphobia. • Problem with the statistics measuring hate speech. The most conspicuous source of hate speech is the extreme right wing, and particularly the National Democratic Party (NPD). And it is represented in the parliaments of the Länder of Saxony and Mecklenburg-Vorpommern.	The working methods for the preparation of the reports involve documentary analyses, a visit to the country concerned, and then a confidential dialogue with the national authorities.
