The possible establishment of a Human Rights House and the attachment of the institutions concerned to parliament would serve to increase their independence and neutrality. The Luxembourg authorities have informed ECRI of their support for an identical proposal by the CET but do not, however, refer to enabling it to take part in legal proceedings or requiring the persons or bodies to which it addresses itself to reply.	The working methods for the preparation of the reports involve documentary analyses, a visit to the country concerned, and then a confidential dialogue with the national authorities.
