The police has issued instructions for the classification of hate crime incidents to improve relevant statistics on this matter. Police officers have also participated in training events of the EU Fundamental Rights Agency (FRA) and the OSCE Office for Democratic Institutions and Human Rights (ODIHR) on monitoring hate crime. In addition, the Police University College conducts an annual study on alleged hate crime incidents that have been brought to the attention of the police. Furthermore, the Office of the Prosecutor General organises trainings for prosecutors on racist criminal offences and has also set up a working group for this topic.	The working methods for the preparation of the reports involve documentary analyses, a visit to the country concerned, and then a confidential dialogue with the national authorities.
