Ethnic profiling	Cyprus, Anti-discrimination Authority	The report found that profile analysis by law enforcement agencies, often manifested in 'stop-and-search' police practices, is permitted when it relies on a person's conduct but is unlawful if it relies entirely on one's ethnic, racial or religious characteristics. Using as case studies two different instances of racial profiling of migrants by the police which evidently relied on the person's skin colour or migrant background, the report concluded that such profile analysis infringes both the Racial Equality Directive and the Framework Decision on Racism and Xenophobia.
