Furthermore, from 2014 to 2016, the National Council for Combatting Discrimination and the National Institute of Magistracy ran a project to strengthen anti-discriminatory measures at national level, which involved different participants such as teachers, police officers and school inspectors, as well as the judiciary. While these initiatives seem to have helped enhance the application of anti-discrimination measures, ECRI observes that their target groups have been limited to certain occupations and that no specific awareness-raising campaign focusing on the public at large has taken place. ECRI has been informed that a new module was introduced within the Electronic Court Record Information System (ECRIS) which generates data on the basis of "hate motivation deed". ECRI considers that the above-mentioned measures signify progress but there is still no comprehensive data collection system available on the application of criminal law provisions against racism and racial discrimination, as recommended.	The working methods for the preparation of the reports involve documentary analyses, a visit to the country concerned, and then a confidential dialogue with the national authorities.
