In Hungary, data on hate crimes are not disaggregated by bias motivation and are only listed under "violence against a member of a community". The Working Group against Hate Crimes provides trainings for the Hungarian police and developed guidance for them to identify bias motivation.	This report presents qualitative (reports, guidelines) and quantitative information (databases on hate crimes).	The report compares data of the Member States from 2007 to 2017 by using national databases of ministries, police, foreign offices, statistical offices.
