Whereas 40 % had experienced some form of discrimination during the last 12 months, 43.2 % of the respondents from Middle East and North Africa had done so. The most common form of discrimination was being target of negative comments. 29.3 % of the respondents from Middle East and North Africa had experienced this at least once during the previous year. Only respondents from other parts of Africa experienced more such forms of discrimination (45.5 %).	Qualitative study using electronic questionnaires together with paper questionnaires and phone calls when necessary.	Information gathered between May 2018 and January 2019 in connection with the FinMonik survey on well-being among foreign born population.
