After a rapid rise of hate speech at the time of mass arrival of refugees to Slovenia in 2015, instances of hate speech were less common in the subsequent period. According to the report, this did not necessarily reflect the situation regarding hate speech in the country, but might be a result of a reluctance to report such incidents on the part of persons concerned, as the wording of the relevant legal provisions and its strict interpretations by authorities hardly guaranteed prosecution of the perpetrators. | Country visit (5 to 13 April 2018)   | N/A                                   | Not applicable - national level         |
