Discrimination	The Netherlands, Netherlands Institute for Human Rights (College voor de Rechten van de Mens)	Of a sample of 910 persons who experienced discrimination in public space in 2019, 126 persons (14%) experienced discrimination on the ground religion and 258 persons (28%) experienced discrimination on the ground race. 90% of these incidents concerned verbal insults.	This study was carried out by using a structured questionnaire in which respondents were asked for their experiences of discrimination in public. In April 2020 the research institute Kantar made a sample from the NIPO-base panel (which consists of approximately 113.000 persons). This sample consisted of 2.073 persons older than 18. The were asked to fill in an online questionnaire. 1.726 did fill in the questionnaire (a response rate of 83,2 %). Of these, 1.007 participants indicated that they had at least one experience of discriminatory behaviour in public space, 910 of them on the basis of one of the legally protected personal characteristics (grounds for discrimination).
