On the issue of social distance (the extent to which young people find it acceptable to have a given minority in their everyday environment), it was found that the respondents are most likely to distance themselves from Roma, followed by Muslims. On the issue of coexistence, Roma are rated the worst, followed by the homeless, and Muslims in third place. Younger respondents (15 - 30 years old) expressed more positive attitudes towards minorities.	quantitative (online panel survey, CAWI)	Age 15-30 (N = 1008); Age 21-36 (N = 1004); Comparison group - analogous to the 2014 survey (N = 1343).
