The report notes that racially motivated hate crimes constitutes the majority of cases (360 cases out of the total of 635 cases) followed by religiously motivated hate crimes (194 cases out of 635 cases - corresponding to 31 pct.). Out of the religiously motivated hated crimes, 45 pct. of the cases were targeted at Muslims. | Quantitative (registry-based study) | Not applicable | Not applicable - national level |
