According to the analysis provided in the report, the far-right scene in Austria has been represented by two main currents for around a decade: traditional neo-Nazism on the one hand and the 'New Right' on the other. Leading groups and circles have established themselves in both the neo-Nazi movement and the 'New Right', which attempted to realise the defined goal with the help of different topics during the observation period. First and foremost, the anti-Islam, anti-asylum and xenophobic explanatory patterns should be mentioned here, but also the clearly recognisable ambition to fuel existing hostility towards democracy with radical fundamentalist criticism of the official COVID-19 measures.
