Of the remaining 1,796 hate crimes, depending on the protected group, we obtain the following distribution: racism/xenophobia (42.04%), sexual orientation and gender identity (25.56%), ideology (13.64%), sex/gender (10.52%), religious beliefs or practices (2.62%), disability (1.28%), anti-Gypsyism (1.22%), aporophobia (0.95%), generational discrimination (0.83%), anti-Semitism (0.72%), and disease (0.61%).
