It analyses the extreme right represented by VOX political party in Spain. It aimed to provide a perspective, focusing not only on the causes of the emergence of extreme right political movements but also on how the political parties articulate their communication and political action. Migration and particularly that from countries where majority of population are Muslims, was the daily predilection of their attacks. Migrants were gathered and labelled as a threat to the survival of the "nación" as potential criminals, and as incapable of assimilating into contemporary European societies.
