It examines mobilization against anti-Muslim hatred in the city of Roubaix, specifically through two types of collective actors: places of worship and "associations fighting against the stigmatization of Muslims." The article demonstrates that "for opposite reasons — institutional recognition in one case, disqualification in the other — these actors are unable or no longer able to serve as effective mobilizers against Islamophobia. In response to a controversy deemed Islamophobic, the mosques of Roubaix federated and established harmonious relations with public authorities, regardless of political affiliation, leading to the construction of several large-scale religious buildings and official recognition of their place in the city, but moving them away from any oppositional stance. On the other hand, more militant associations, though they initially received public funding, were quickly criticized for alleged 'communitarianism,' and successive controversies contributed to their marginalization. These collective trajectories help explain the observed demobilization on the ground, despite a diffuse politicization linked to the stigmatization of Muslims."
