It does not explicitly mention discrimination against specific national or ethnic groups within the asylum process. However, it highlights concerns related to applicants from designated 'safe countries of origin' undergoing accelerated procedures, which may limit their access to legal advice and adequate accommodation. These include some Muslim-majority countries.	Qualitative methodology, combining desk-based research with direct correspondence to gather data. Includes analysis of - statistics from the International Protection Office (IPO) and the International Protection Accommodation Service (IPAS), including annual and monthly reports; - data from the International Protection Appeals Tribunal (IPAT); - insights from stakeholders such as the Irish Human Rights and Equality Commission, UNHCR Ireland, and NGOs working with refugees and asylum seekers; - the Irish Refugee Council's casework and policy work.
