The Police registered 272 incidents about Muslim discrimination in 2023 (3% of all discrimination incidents registered by the police in 2023) and the antidiscrimination bureaus or services registered 202 incidents about Muslim discrimination (5% of all discrimination incidents registered by the antidiscrimination services or bureaus in 2023). These incidents are for a great deal incidents concerning hostile language and cursing (161 incidents of the 202 incidents registered by the antidiscrimination services).	This report is based on reports of experienced discrimination or discrimination incidents (including Muslim discrimination) as registered by the Dutch police and the Dutch antidiscrimination services in the year 2023.
