In addition, financial resources to implementation plans on integration and inclusion for foreigners are not sufficient. The report notes that Anti-Muslim violence in Lithuania, where the traditional Tatar community (which makes up the majority of the Muslims in the country) is generally respected, is rather rare, but mentions 2 cases.	ECRI, an independent human rights monitoring body of the Council of Europe, monitors racism, discrimination, and intolerance in member states through five-year cycles. Its reports are based on documentary analyses, on-site visits and dialogue with national authorities. The sixth round focuses on effective equality, hate speech and violence, and integration, while addressing country-specific issues. Information is gathered from diverse sources rather than direct inquiries. Authorities can comment on drafts and request their views be appended.
