Despite legislative gains and better access to education, issues like systemic discrimination, poor housing, and lack of identity documents persist. Hate rhetoric - including anti-Roma, anti-Muslim, and antisemitic speech - continues from some politicians and media. A Friedrich Ebert Foundation study shows growing ethnocentrism, with only 22% of respondents open to co-residing with Turks and 15% to family ties. Although Muslims make up 10.8% of the population, mosque availability is limited, and halal food has been denied in Turkish-majority kindergartens. Minority language education remains low, with a sharp drop in Turkish language instruction despite 8.7% reporting it as their mother tongue. The Committee calls for urgent action to safeguard minority cultures, expand healthcare access, improve participation in decision-making, and increase funding for cultural programs, alongside structural reforms for equality and inclusion.
