It also highlights information showing an increase in incidents of racist hate speech during the reporting period in the form of xenophobia, Afrophobia, anti-Gypsyism, antisemitism and Islamophobia, including in sports, in the media and on the Internet, including discriminatory remarks made by political and public figures. The Committee further expresses concern about reports and information indicating the persistence of racially motivated violence, ill-treatment, racial profiling, abuse of authority and excessive use of force by police officers against ethnic minorities and migrants, in particular Roma and people of African descent.
