**Questions and Answers I**

**Question 1:**

Would it be possible to provide us with the questionnaire that was used during the previous project 2013?

**Answer 1:**

As indicated in Section 2.3. *Preparatory work for the Second European Union Minorities and Discrimination Survey (EU-MIDIS II)* on page 8 of Annex A.1 Technical Specifications, in 2014 FRA conducted a cognitive pre-test study in eight EU Member States to inform the design of the questionnaire for the EU-MIDIS II full scale survey. The results of the cognitive pre-test are considered a building block in the development of the EU-MIDIS II questionnaire and as stated in the Technical Specifications in Section 1.3 on p. 19, FRA will provide the future contractor with the results of the EU-MIDIS II pre-test study. Some questions from the previous EU-MIDIS and Roma surveys will be repeated in EU-MIDIS II to allow for analysis of trends. **Question 2:**

Could you tell us if it is possible to make an offer for a few countries only, or does it have to be for all of them?

**Answer 2:**

It is **not possible** to submit an offer only for a few countries. As mentioned in section 2 of Annex A – Tender Specifications, submission of a tender for only some of the tasks to be performed under the contract will lead to the rejection of the tender. Moreover, section 18 of Annex A establishes, as a minimum requirement, that technical offers must cover all 28 EU Member States.
