Additional Information

Ádám Varga graduated from Pázmány Péter Catholic University (PPCU) in 2011 and earned his PhD at the same university in 2020. As a student, he was the independent deputy mayor (temporarily acting as mayor) in a small village (Felsőpáhok) and, after his graduation, worked at the prosecutor's office. Since 2017, he has been working at the Constitutional Court, where he is currently a Chief Counsellor. Since 2012, he has also been teaching constitutional law and public administrative law at PPCU, where he is currently a senior assistant professor.

He is author of more than 70 scientific publications in both Hungarian and English languages, as well as has given dozens conference presentations in Hungarian, English and German languages.

His main research interests include:

- The nature and enforcement of collective fundamental rights to self-government (studies, book chapters in Hungarian and English; a monograph in Hungarian)
- Characteristics and enforcement of certain fundamental rights – minority rights, right to fair trial, rule of law, asylum, children's rights, right to property, right to a healthy environment, right to information compensation (studies in

Hungarian and English)

- The constitutional status of the prosecution service and the importance of the protection of the public interest by the prosecutors (studies and book in Hungarian)
- Administrative sanctions (studies and book chapters in Hungarian)
- Constitutional judicature (book chapters in Hungarian)
