Questions and Answers II

Question 1:

We noted that a minimum of four countries (out of five possible EU Member States on page 9) are required for the research in Component I (interception/rescue at sea), but in the list of deliverables (p. 19-24), five of each related deliverable are required (background information reports, sets of factsheets, background reports, and country reports). Is this an error in the technical specifications? Should it not read four in each of these cases?

Answer 1:

Ideally, for component one, the contractor is expected to cover all five EU countries (Cyprus, Greece, Italy, Malta and Spain) and thus to produce five of each related deliverables. Should component one, for whatever reason, only cover four countries, the corresponding deliverables listed on pages 19-24 will be four and not five.
