

## Roma Survey - Country Data - Czechia

### Survey & EU targets

- **Respondents:** in Czechia, 998 Roma took part in the survey, representing 1403 household members.
- **EU-level objectives:** Czechia is likely to meet the 2030 targets only in one EU-level objective: housing.

### Discrimination & antigypsyism

- **Discrimination:** 42% of Roma in Czechia say they were discriminated against in the year before the survey compared to 32% in 2016 (EU-total: 31%).
- **Harassment:** 41% of Roma in Czechia experienced hate-motivated harassment in the year before the survey, compared to 56% in 2016 (EU-total: 19%).

### Participation, reporting & trust

- **Reporting:** Only 7% of Roma in Czechia reported discrimination to an official body, compared to 24% in 2016 (EU-total: 6%).
- **Trust in police:** 35% of Roma in Czechia tend to trust the police, compared to 33% in 2016 (EU-total: 49%). This compares to 78% of the general Czech population.

### Poverty

- **Poverty:** 52% of Roma in Czechia are at risk of poverty, compared to 58% in 2016 (the EU-total: 70%). This compares to 10% of the general Czech population.
- **Child poverty:** 70% of Roma children in Czechia are at risk of poverty, compared to 65% in 2016 (EU-total: 77%). This compares to 14% of children in Czech Republic in general.
- **Severe material deprivation:** 25% of Roma in Czechia live in severe materials deprivation, compared to 51% in 2016 (EU-total: 37%). This compares to 2% of the Czech population in general.

### Education

- **Early childhood education:** 48% of Roma children in Czechia attend early childhood education, compared to 24% in 2016 (EU-total: 53%). This compares to 85% of Czech children in general.
- **Educational attainment:** 17% of young Roma in Czechia have completed at least upper-secondary education, compared to 38% in 2016 (EU-total: 32%). This compares to 90% of the general Czech population.
- **Segregation:** 58% of Roma children in Czechia attend a school where all or most pupils are Roma, compared to 29% in 2016 (EU-total: 46%).

### Work

- **Employment:** 55% of Roma in Czechia are in paid work, compared to 43% in 2016 (EU-total: 54%). This compares to 82% of Czech people generally.

- **NEET rates:** 48% of young Roma in Czechia are neither in employment, education or training, compared to 50% in 2016 (EU-total: 47%). This compares to 6% of young people in Czech Republic generally.
- **Work discrimination:** 47% of Roma in Czechia felt discriminated against when looking for work compared to 28% in 2016 (EU-total: 36%). 27% felt discriminated at work, compared to 6% in 2016 (EU-total: 22%).

## Housing

- **Housing deprivation:** in Czechia, 27% of Roma live in housing deprivation, compared to 33% in 2016 (EU-total: 47%). This compares to 10% of the general Czech population.
- **Overcrowding:** 81% of Roma in Czechia live in an overcrowded housing, compared to 83% in 2016 (EU-total: 83%). This compares to 17% of the overall Czech population.
- **Housing discrimination:** 45% of Roma in Czechia felt discriminated against when looking for housing, compared to 65% in 2016 (EU-total: 35%).

## Health

- **Health discrimination:** 22% of Roma in Czechia felt discriminated against when accessing healthcare, compared to 8% in 2016 (EU-total: 16%).
