

## Roma Survey - Country Data - France

### Survey & EU targets

- **Respondents:** in France, 430 Roma took part in the survey, representing 716 household members.
- **EU-level objectives:** France is not likely to achieve any of the targets by 2030.

### Discrimination & antigypsyism

- **Discrimination:** 45% of Roma in France say they were discriminated against in the year before the survey compared to 35% in 2019 (EU-total: 31%).
- **Harassment:** 19% of Roma in France experienced hate-motivated harassment in the year before the survey, compared to 35% in 2019 (EU-total: 19%).

### Participation, reporting & trust

- **Reporting:** Only 5% of Roma in France reported discrimination to an official body, compared to 15% in 2019 (EU-total: 6%).
- **Trust in police:** 30% of Roma in France tend to trust the police, compared to 29% in 2019 (EU-total: 49%). This compares to 74% of the general French population.

### Poverty

- **Poverty:** 92% of Roma in France are at risk of poverty (the EU-total: 70%). This compares to 15% of the general French population.
- **Child poverty:** 96% of Roma children in France are at risk of poverty (EU-total: 77%). This compares to 22% of children in France in general.
- **Severe material deprivation:** 24% of Roma in France live in severe material deprivation, compared to 22% in 2019 (EU-total: 37%). This compares to 5% of the French population in general.

### Education

- **Early childhood education:** 44% of Roma children in France attend early childhood education, compared to 26% in 2019 (EU-total: 53%). This compares to 100% of French children in general.
- **Educational attainment:** 12% of young Roma in France have completed at least upper-secondary education, compared to 12% in 2019 (EU-total: 32%). This compares to 91% of the general French population.
- **Segregation:** 29% of Roma children in France attend a school where all or most pupils are Roma, compared to 9% in 2019 (EU-total: 46%).

### Work

- **Employment:** 39% of Roma in France are in paid work, compared to 37% in 2019 (EU-total: 54%). This compares to 74% of French people generally.

- **NEET rates:** 54% of young Roma in France are neither in employment, education or training, compared to 61% in 2019 (EU-total: 47%). This compares to 11% of young people in France generally.
- **Work discrimination:** 40% of Roma in France felt discriminated against when looking for work compared to 22% in 2019 (EU-total: 36%). 35% felt discriminated at work, compared to 12% in 2019 (EU-total: 22%).

## Housing

- **Housing deprivation:** in France, 71% of Roma live in housing deprivation, compared to 55% in 2019 (EU-total: 47%). This compares to 28% of the general French population.
- **Overcrowding:** 84% of Roma in France live in an overcrowded housing, compared to 54% in 2019 (EU-total: 83%). This compares to 10% of the overall French population.
- **Housing discrimination:** 55% of Roma in France felt discriminated against when looking for housing, compared to 29% in 2019 (EU-total: 35%).

## Health

- **Health discrimination:** 18% of Roma in France felt discriminated against when accessing healthcare, compared to 5% in 2019 (EU-total: 16%).
