Michal evaluated the compatibility of draft legislation with the EU law and the European Convention on Human Rights while working for the Legislation Section of the Office of the Slovak Government and participated in various national working groups for transposition of EU law including Equality Directives.

Since 2012 he has been practising advocacy, including representation before the Constitutional Court of the Slovak Republic and the European Court of Human Rights.

Since 2018 has been serving as a member (nominated by NGOs) of the Council of the Slovak Government for Human Rights, Minorities and Gender Equality. Also served as a Board Member of the Amnesty International in Slovakia (2013-2017) and since 2017 he is a Board Member of the OLYMP civic association that organizes the Human Rights Olympics – project educating students in human rights and democratic citizenship for more than 20 years. He provides legal assistance for various NGOs.

Michal holds Master law degree from the Šafarik University (SK, 2006), LL.M. in European and International Law from the University of Aberdeen (UK, 2010), Ph.D. in European and International Law from the Masaryk University (CZ, 2012), JUDr. in Public International Law from the Trnava University (SK, 2009).
